ARTIST/VENDOR RULES & REGULATIONS

1. You must be at your booth by 12:00pm on each day. Booths must be maintained during convention hours at all times.
2. Once you receive your Temporary Health Permit, it is mandatory that you have it posted at your booth during convention hours.
3. No one under 18 will be tattooed or pierced. Anyone found doing so will be asked to leave and will not be invited back.
4. There will be a strict minimum of \$30.00 on all piercings and \$50.00 on all tattoos. Anyone not adhering to this rule will be asked to leave immediately and will not be invited back.
5. After every tattoo, it is required that you wrap the patron with a bandage.
6. You are to give every client an aftercare sheet, informing them of the various duties and responsibilities involved in having a piece of art or piercing.
7. Please be advised that all attendees are expected to be on their best behavior and respect the hotel and venue. There will be security monitoring all events and floors. Any damage during or after convention hours will be billed to the shop(s) or person(s) responsible.
8. It is mandatory that ALL artists/piercers comply with all Southern Nevada Health District requirements at all times or you will be asked to leave and will not be invited back. *(see attached Southern Nevada Health District Artist Checklist for details)*
9. You must provide your own light source. *(see Southern Nevada Health District Artist Checklist for details)*
10. You must provide your own surge protector and extension cords.
11. With each paid booth registration, each shop/vendor will receive two (2) complimentary weekend event passes. All other employees and/or spouses will pay a discounted weekend fee of only \$15.00 (per pass) prior to deadline date. Passes may also be purchased at the door during convention hours for \$20.00 (per pass).
12. All trashcans must be placed at front of booth nightly for pickup.
13. Booths and stations are to be kept clean and sterile at all times.
14. Consumption of alcoholic beverages by artists/piercers is prohibited during convention hours. Anyone not adhering to this rule will be asked to leave immediately and will not be invited back.

We will provide:


- a. Sterilizer, thermo fax, and copy machine will be available in the convention area.
- b. Trashcans and liners along with bio-hazardous/sharps containers and liners for every booth.
- c. For Artist Booths – two tables, four chairs and for Vendor booths – two tables, two chairs.
- d. All stations will be dressed with tablecloths, table skirts, plastic floor protectors, three (3) - 3' pipe and drape siding and one (1) - 10' pipe and drape backing.
- e. Hand washing stations

By giving my signature below, I attest that I have read and agree to the above rules and regulations. Should I have a problem adhering to these rules, I understand that I will be asked to leave and will not be invited to return to future conventions.

 Use the following checklist to ensure that you and your booth are ready for inspection by the time specified on your permit application. Failure to set-up properly may result in denial of the health permit.

1. The facility where the Body Art Special Event will be conducted must be inspected by the Health Authority and a Health Permit must be issued prior to any tattoo or body piercing procedures being performed.
2. A Health Permit to operate at the Body Art Special Event must be posted at each booth.
3. Standard booth size is 10 feet by 10 feet. Under no circumstances may the booth size exceed 150 square feet. Each artist must have at least fifty (50) square feet of floor space. (This is an exception for the Body Art Special Events only.)
4. There must be at least fifty (50) foot candles of light at the level where the tattoo, permanent makeup or body piercing is being performed.
5. All walls, floors, ceilings and operating surfaces of the booth shall be made of smooth, nonabsorbent and nonporous material that is easily cleanable and shall be maintained in a sanitary manner at all times. It is acceptable to apply plastic to meet this requirement.
6. Adequate, conveniently located hand washing facilities, as approved by the Health Authority, with liquid soap, paper towels and hot and cold water under adequate pressure and drained in accordance with local plumbing codes.
7. Single-use gloves and disinfecting single-use hand wipes, approved by the Health Authority, in addition to the hand washing requirements of this section, must be available in each booth.
8. Instruments must be properly sterilized-evidence of spore testing performed on sterilization equipment thirty (30) days or less prior to the date of the event, must be provided; or, only single-use, prepackaged, sterilized equipment obtained from reputable suppliers/manufacturers will be allowed.
9. Tattoo machines and autoclave/dry heat sterilizer clean and in good repair.
10. Labeled red "sharps" container and covered trash receptacle.
11. Artist's hair properly restrained and no smoking or eating in procedural booths.
12. A sample of the Client Consent Form submitted with the application must be given to the Health Inspector upon inspection and must include the following information:
 - Name, age, address, date of tattoo/piercing, operator's name, place where tattooed or body part pierced and a description of the design or the type of jewelry inserted, and client signature line.
 - A statement advising that the tattoo should be considered permanent; that it can only be removed with a surgical procedure; and that any effective removal may leave permanent scarring and disfigurement.
 - Questionnaire asking if the client has a history of jaundice or Hepatitis within twelve (12) months preceding the date of tattoo or piercing. If the answer is in the affirmative, the tattoo procedure must not be performed.
13. A sample of the Client Instruction Form submitted with the application must be given to the Health Inspector upon inspection and must include the following information:
 - Proper follow-up care of the tattoo/pierced skin.
 - Possible side effects.
 - Activity restrictions, if any.
